You may be interested to know the sources of our new Introit for Lent. The refrain music is by our own Ned Wetherald with words adapted from a paraphrase of the Ten Commandments by David Gambrell, Associate for Worship, Office of Theology and Worship, PC (USA). The verses are the above paraphrase, which will be sung by the choir or cantor, are set to the tune "Les Commandements De Dieu" written by Louis Bourgeois (who also wrote "Old Hundredth") and used in the 1547 Genevan Psalter to sing the Ten Commandments and Psalm 140. There's a good chance John Calvin sang the Ten Commandments to this tune.
